



# AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY CRICKET CLUB

## PLAYING CRICKET AT ANUCC 2023-24 SEASON.

### Objects

1. The objects of the ANUCC are:
  - (a) to promote, develop and manage the game of cricket within the Australian National University, its community and the community that neighbours and interacts with it;
  - (b) To maintain a strong, connected and accepting community for people of all backgrounds and personalities sharing a love for cricket;
  - (b) to participate in cricket competitions; and
  - (c) to co-operate with any person or organisation for those purposes.

### Membership

2. ANUCC Membership is divided into four categories:
  - (a) Senior Playing Members;
  - (b) Junior Playing Members;
  - (c) Non-playing Members; and
  - (d) Life Members,  
(together, **ANUCC Members**)

### Member responsibilities / Code of Conduct

3. To become a member of ANUCC, you are required to register via PlayHQ and pay the relevant registration fee.

4. All members are required to be members of ANU Sport. If you are an ANU student you are a member of ANU Sport, however if you are not an ANU student, you need to register as a member of ANU Sport via UniOne portal.

### Clothing

5. Masuri is the current clothing provider for the club, and a range of playing and training clothing is available for purchase via the club. Generally, clothing will be sold at training or via online ordering.



## **Training**

6. Training is conducted on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons during the season (generally October to March), and members are expected to attend at least one training per week. If you are playing 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, the expectation would be to attend two trainings per week. Non-attendance must be communicated as early as possible to your coach or captain with a reason why.
7. Pre-season and additional training sessions during the season will be communicated to all members.
8. During the training session, members are expected to follow the directions of the coaches/training manager; and to be involved in all aspects of training (eg batting, bowling and fielding) at each session.
9. It is expected that club training clothes are worn during training sessions.

## **Match day**

10. Arrive at the ground one hour prior to the commencement of the game, or as directed by the captain.
11. Covers need to be removed based on the direction of curators. For North Oval, this usually is by 8am. For South Oval, this is usually by 9am. Removal of covers at this time ensures the curator is able to work on the pitch on Saturday morning. If there is another game at the ground the next day, covers will need to be replaced at the end of play.
12. If playing at home, players should contribute to the set up of the ground prior to play. At all grounds this will involve putting out stumps, boundary markers and scoreboard numbers, moving sight screens to behind the bowlers arm and mixing cordial for drinks. At 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades this will also involve setting up Frogbox. At North Oval, it will also involve putting out sponsor advertising. It is all member's responsibility to ensure the ground is ready for play, not just the captain.
13. Should you require a match ball, access to ground/pavilion or clothing and other match day equipment, contact the Match Day Coordinator in the first instance.
14. Club clothing should be worn to the ground, and during warm-ups.
15. It is expected that ANUCC playing clothing is worn during games.

## **Post match**

16. There will be post match gatherings at North Oval after each game.
17. During the season there will be other events such as season launch and presentation night that all members are encouraged to attend.



### Playing availability

18. The club will request availability via email at the beginning of the week before each round. It is each player's responsibility to complete the availability on time, and honour the availability provided (not withdraw after the teams are selected).

### Communication

19. Communication relating to selections and match details will be conveyed via email to all registered players.

20. Details of social events will be conveyed via email or social media.
